DESCRIPTION

The Onda sofa, designed by the Italian trio Jonathan De Pas, Donato D'Urbino, and Paolo Lomazzi for Zanotta in 1985, is a quintessential piece of postmodern design. Its name, meaning "wave" in Italian, perfectly captures its fluid and organic silhouette, reminiscent of the gentle movement of water. This two-seater sofa is distinguished by its soft, enveloping curves that provide exceptional comfort and visual appeal.

Crafted with a wavy steel frame, the Onda is adorned with thick, luxurious cushions covered in grey leather. This

striking combination of form and function makes the Onda a statement piece that enhances any contemporary interior.
