DESCRIPTION

Armchair model D42 published by Tecta, Germany, circa 1980.

Its tubular steel frame, designed in the Bauhaus spirit, forms a cantilever base ending in curved runners. The seat and backrest, woven in natural cane, provide both comfort and flexibility, while the rattan-covered armrests extend the harmony of the weaving. Inspired by the historic models of Marcel Breuer and Ludwig Mies van der Rohe, the D42 chair reflects Tecta's commitment to reissuing and adapting modernist classics.
