## DESCRIPTION

---

Set of six solid pine chairs designed by Rainer Daumiller in the early 1970s in Denmark.

The structure is entirely crafted in solid pine, featuring a thick, slightly curved backrest fitted into rounded uprights. The circular solid wood seat rests on a sturdy base with softened, substantial sections. The lines are organic, without sharp edges, emphasizing comfort and direct engagement with the material. The pronounced pine grain is integral to the identity of the model.

These chairs reflect Daumiller's approach to simple, functional and durable furniture, where form emerges directly from the material. An iconic example of 1970s Danish design.
