DESCRIPTION

Ottoman or occasional stool produced by Airborne in the 1960s.

The four-legged black lacquered tubular steel structure supports a padded seat, newly upholstered with a bouclé fabric by Maison Nobilis. The contrast between the slender frame and the textured upholstery highlights the balance between modernist simplicity and comfort.
