## DESCRIPTION

---

Ceramic tile after a design by Jean Lurçat, produced by the Sant Vicens workshop in Perpignan in the 1950s.

Square in format, it features a vibrant stylized composition characteristic of the artist's graphic language, combining organic forms with a free composition. The bright glazes, blending red, yellow, white and blue over a brown ground, emphasize the painterly quality of the piece.

The reverse bears a handwritten inscription reading "Dessine J. Lurçat" along with Sant Vicens, confirming this collaboration between artists and ceramists in the post-war period.
