DESCRIPTION

Published by the Japanese manufacturer Tendo Mokko in the 1960s, this sideboard is crafted from solid teak and teak veneer with a warm and regular grain. It opens with two hinged teak doors on the sides and two central sliding doors in smoked glass, revealing a versatile storage space with adjustable shelves.

The structure rests on tubular metal legs, giving the piece both visual lightness and modernity in contrast with the natural richness of the wood. This combination of materials embodies the postwar Japanese aesthetic, characterized by

refined craftsmanship and openness to Western modernist influences.
