A hallmark of mid-century innovation, Oscar furniture stood out for its adaptability and versatility, offering modular elements that could be divided, reconfigured, and tailored to suit any space. Celebrated for its craftsmanship, the brand received the prestigious silver medal at the 10th Milan Triennale in 1953, cementing its reputation for quality and ingenuity.

This elegant set, in mahogany veneer, features four levels: one equipped with two wooden doors and three with sleek, interchangeable black and white glass doors. The clean lines and modular functionality exemplify the forward-thinking design of the era.
