DESCRIPTION

Pair of solid elm bedside tables designed by Pierre Chapo in the 1970s and produced in France.

Each piece displays the architectural construction characteristic of Chapo's language, with solid uprights, a slightly recessed top and a central body structured by an open niche and a lower drawer. Traditional solid wood joinery highlights the structural rigor associated with the workshop. The dense grain of the elm, enhanced by a warm patina, gives the pair a restrained yet powerful presence.
