DESCRIPTION

Rectangular solid elm table with stretcher base, produced for the Les Arcs resort.

The use of elm, less common for this model, gives the top a distinctive presence, with a broad grain and deeper tone. The structure, clear and stable, reflects an efficient design suited to collective living spaces.

This piece belongs to Charlotte Perriand's work for Les Arcs, where furniture was conceived as part of a broader vision of alpine living.
