DESCRIPTION

Coffee table designed by Daisaku Cho and produced by Tendo Mokko in the 1970s. A key figure in Japanese design, Cho worked under Junzo Sakakura at the Architecture Institute before founding his own studio in 1972.

Crafted from teak veneer and plywood, this table exemplifies Tendo Mokko's mastery of molded plywood techniques. The gracefully curved legs lend it an elegant yet functional presence, making it a timeless piece that suits any interior.
