Folding chair model TS, designed by Roger Tallon (1929-2011) in the 1970s and produced by Sentou around 1978.

This iconic piece, representing the first version of the TS model, exemplifies the brilliance and minimalism of Roger Tallon, a visionary pioneer of industrial design. Crafted from plywood and elegantly finished with an oak veneer, the chair highlights Tallon's mastery of form and function. Its ingenious folding mechanism ensures practical space-saving

utility while maintaining a refined and harmonious aesthetic.

Roger Tallon, celebrated for transformative designs such as the TGV and the Helicoidal staircase, brought his innovative spirit to this collaboration with Sentou, a prominent editor of avant-garde design pieces. This edition seamlessly blends technical ingenuity with artisanal craftsmanship, reflecting the essence of Tallon's timeless approach to design.
