DESCRIPTION

Set of four model S28 chairs in solid elm designed by Pierre Chapo in the mid 1960s and produced by Atelier Chapo in France.

Each chair features a solid wood structure assembled according to Chapo's characteristic cabinetmaking principles, with thick sections and visible joinery. The rectangular seat and gently inclined backrest provide a balanced combination of comfort and formal clarity. The dense elm wood displays a pronounced grain and a natural patina

developed over time, reinforcing the authentic and functional character of the set.

The S28 model belongs to Pierre Chapo's domestic furniture production, conceived for everyday use around the dining table while asserting a strong and lasting architectural presence.
