DESCRIPTION

Created in 1925, resolutely avant-garde, the Wassily armchair and one of the icons of the Bauhaus. Originally called B3, it became the Wassily when it was reedited by Gavina, named after the famous painter Kandinsky, friend and colleague of Marcel Breuer.
