DESCRIPTION

Pair of benches designed by René Martin, known as "René les Ciseaux," a renowned cabinetmaker who collaborated with Charlotte Perriand, circa 1960.

Crafted from solid pine, these benches feature a robust and minimalist construction, embodying the functional and understated aesthetic characteristic of alpine interiors from that period. The thick tabletop rests on two sled-shaped legs, ensuring stability and sturdiness, while a central stretcher reinforces the structure.
