DESCRIPTION

This pair of bedside tables, doubling as stools, envisioned by Pierre Guariche, epitomizes the designer's signature style in furnishing apartments in both La Plagne and Bandol.

Crafted from U-shaped bent plywood and finished with white laminate, these nightstands also include wooden veneer spacers.

Origin: La Plagne, the ski resort where Guariche made a significant impact in the 1960s.
