## **DESCRIPTION**

Designed by Alvar Aalto in 1933 and produced by Artek from 1935 onward, the Model 60 stool reflects the functional and minimalist principles of Scandinavian design. The structure features three bent solid birch legs, a technique refined by Aalto to combine strength with simplified production. The circular seat is made of birch plywood, ensuring both lightness and durability.
