Ceramic sculpture, abstract, figurative or even zoomorphic, hand painted. Open on the below, tentacles intertwine on the top. Jules Agard did not always describe his works with precision. What mattered was what your eye could see, giving free rein to the imagination.

Artist in his own right, Jules Agard was also the one who formed the pots for Picasso at Madoura.
