DESCRIPTION

Pair of wrought iron candlesticks created by Léopold Gest in France during the 1950s.

Each piece features a tripod structure with free and organic lines, formed from twisted iron rods reminiscent of roots or stylized branches. The hammered conical stem is designed to hold a candle, while the overall composition highlights Léopold Gest's sculptural approach to metalwork, balancing craftsmanship and modernist abstraction.
