DESCRIPTION

Floor lamp designed by Professor Carl Moor and produced by BAG Turgi in the end of 1940s.

A key figure in Swiss design, Carl Moor presents here a rare piece that embodies the elegance and precision of Swiss modernism.

This floor lamp stands on a sturdy base, from which slender brass rods rise to support two conical diffusers in white

lacquered metal. Its balanced design plays with contrasts between the lightness of the shades and the solidity of its structure, showcasing BAG Turgi's meticulous craftsmanship.

Combining functionality and refinement, this model reflects Swiss innovation in lighting design and the pursuit of timeless aesthetics.
