DESCRIPTION

1950s bookshelf designed by Didier Rozaffy for the French manufacturer Oscar, known for modular bookshelves and furniture. The company won the silver medal at the Xth Milan Triennale in 1953, a distinction that highlights the quality of its designs.

This mahogany veneer bookshelf features three levels, one of which has interchangeable black and white glass doors, offering great flexibility in arrangement.
