DESCRIPTION

Freeform pine wall-mounted desk designed by Charlotte Perriand, made by the René Martin workshop for the ski resort of Méribel-les-Allues, circa 1960.

Designed to be fixed to the wall, this suspended desk features a solid pine top with soft, organic lines - a hallmark of Perriand's modernist vocabulary. Minimal, functional, and warm, it reflects the care given to alpine interiors during the 1960s.

This piece comes from a private chalet located near Charlotte Perriand's own residence in Méribel, reinforcing its direct connection to her local work.
