DESCRIPTION

Chalet table in solid pine, designed by Christian Durupt in the 1970s. Trained as an architect, Christian Durupt collaborated with Charlotte Perriand on several mountain projects, notably for collective housing developments in Les Arcs.

With its generous solid pine top and H-stretcher base, this table exudes a strong sense of sturdiness and warmth, perfect for gathering family and friends around simple, generous meals.
